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Overview on Swachh Bharat Abhiyan:

5. **Involvement of Technology:** Utilizing technology for monitoring and managing waste, as well as for spreading awareness through digital platforms.
6. **Corporate and NGO Participation:** Encouraging partnerships with businesses and non-governmental organizations to support sanitation projects and contribute resource.
