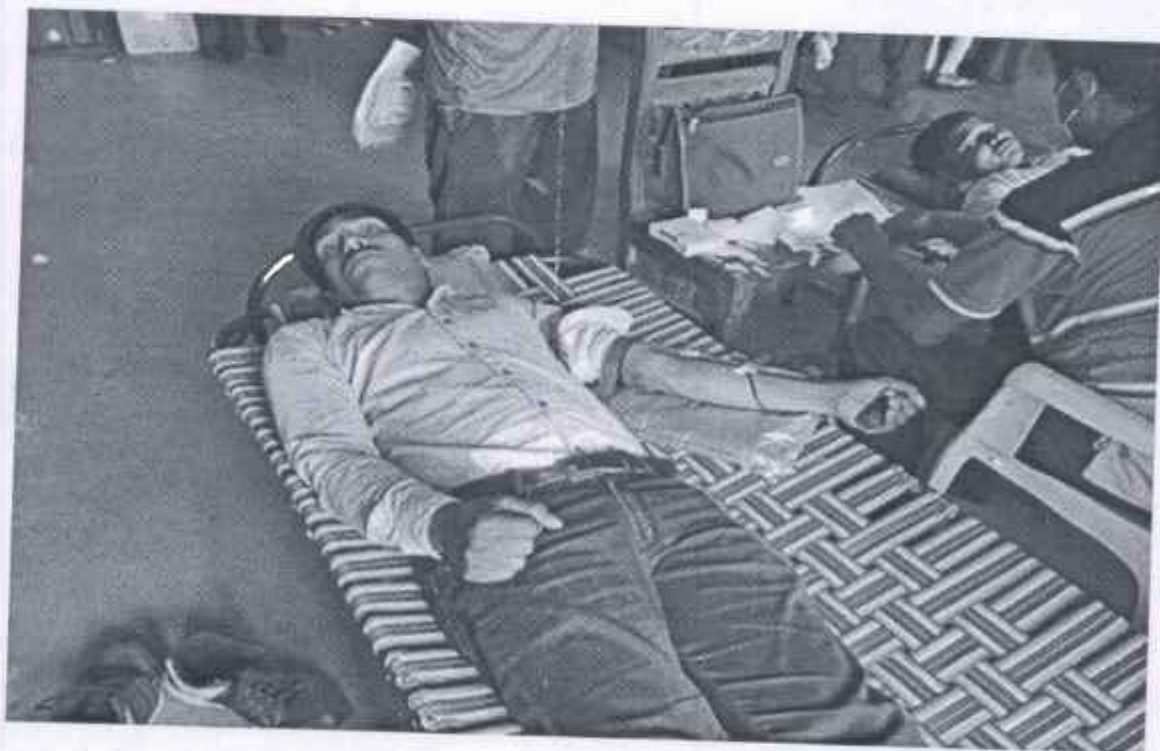
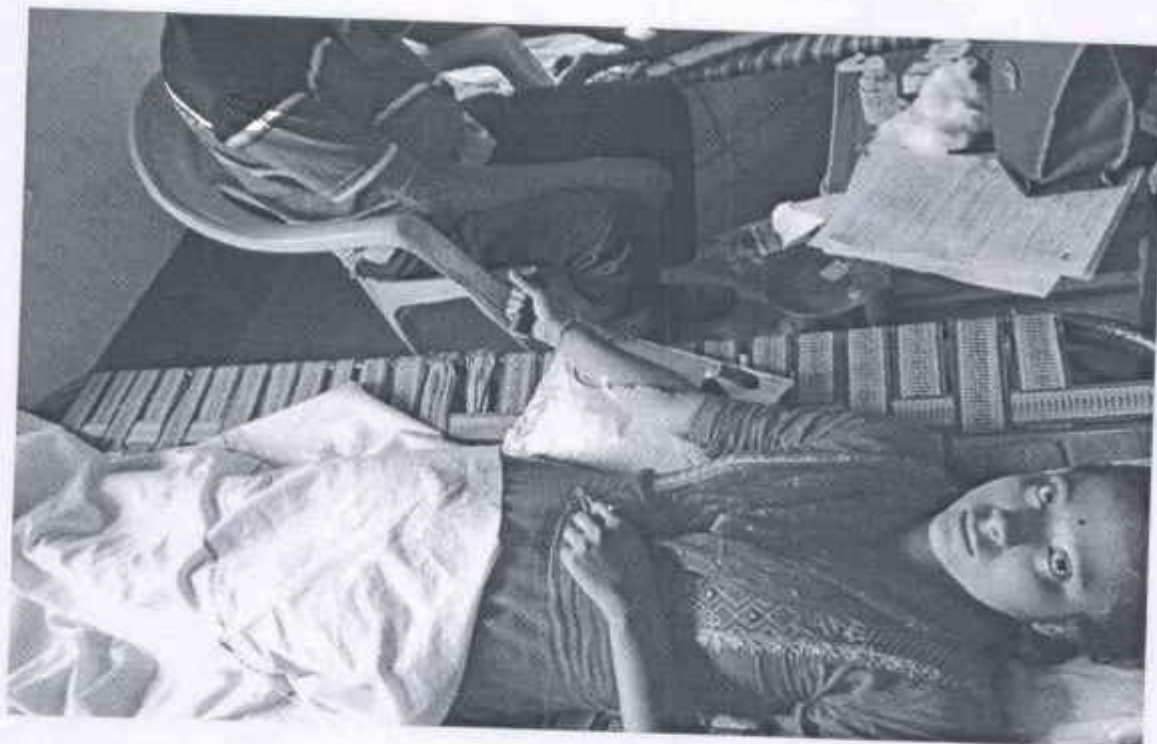
Conclusion



OBJECTIVES:

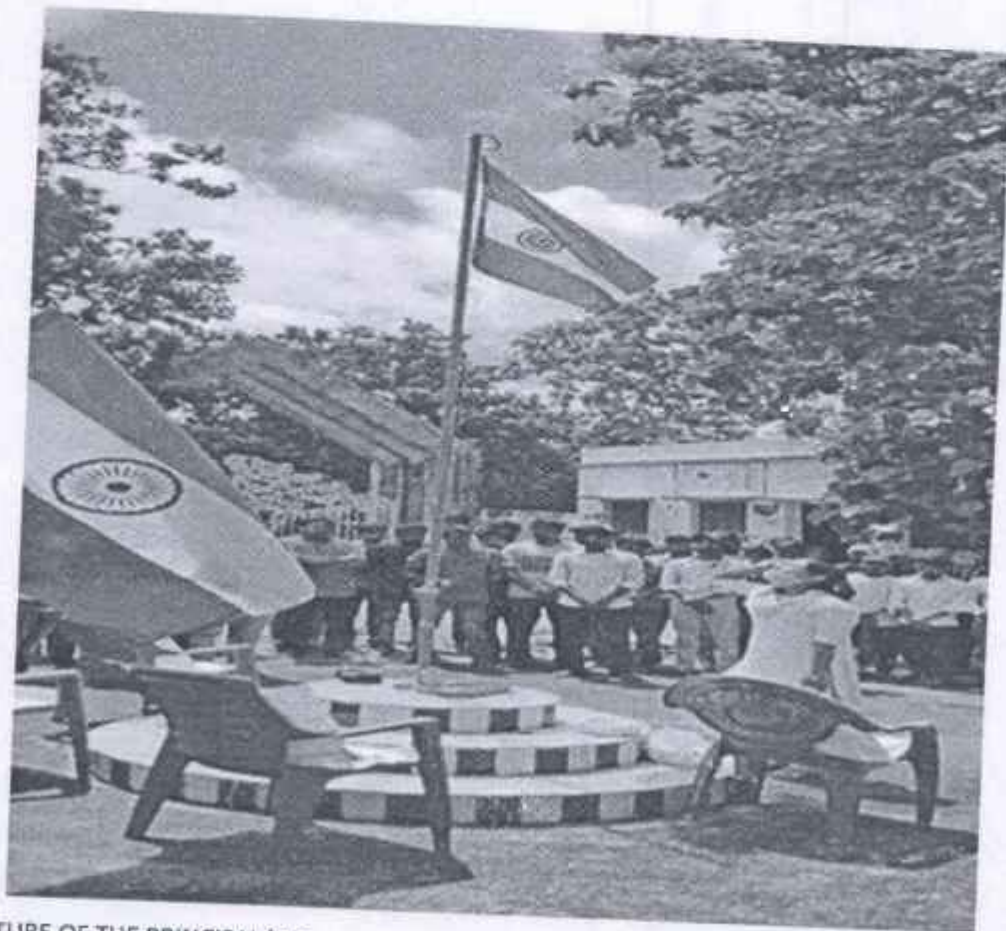
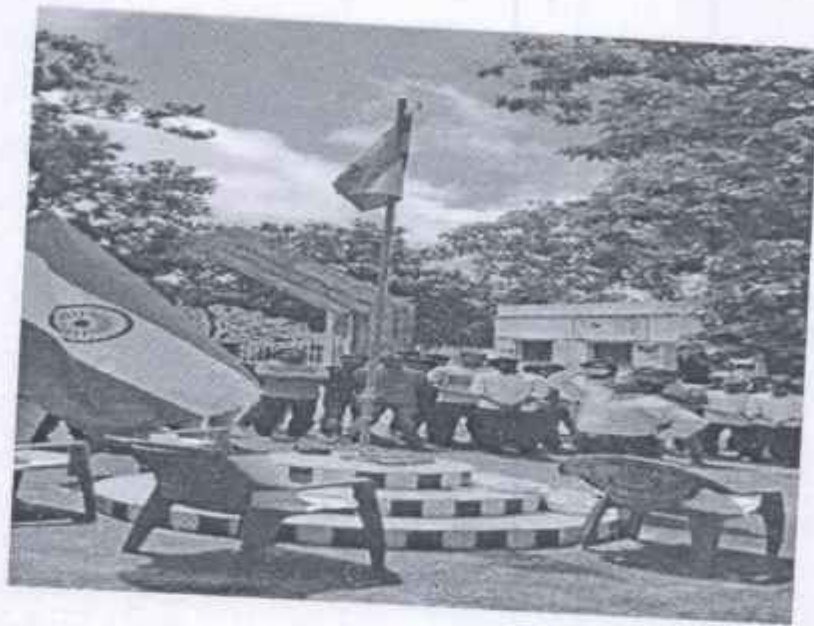

Necessity of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan:

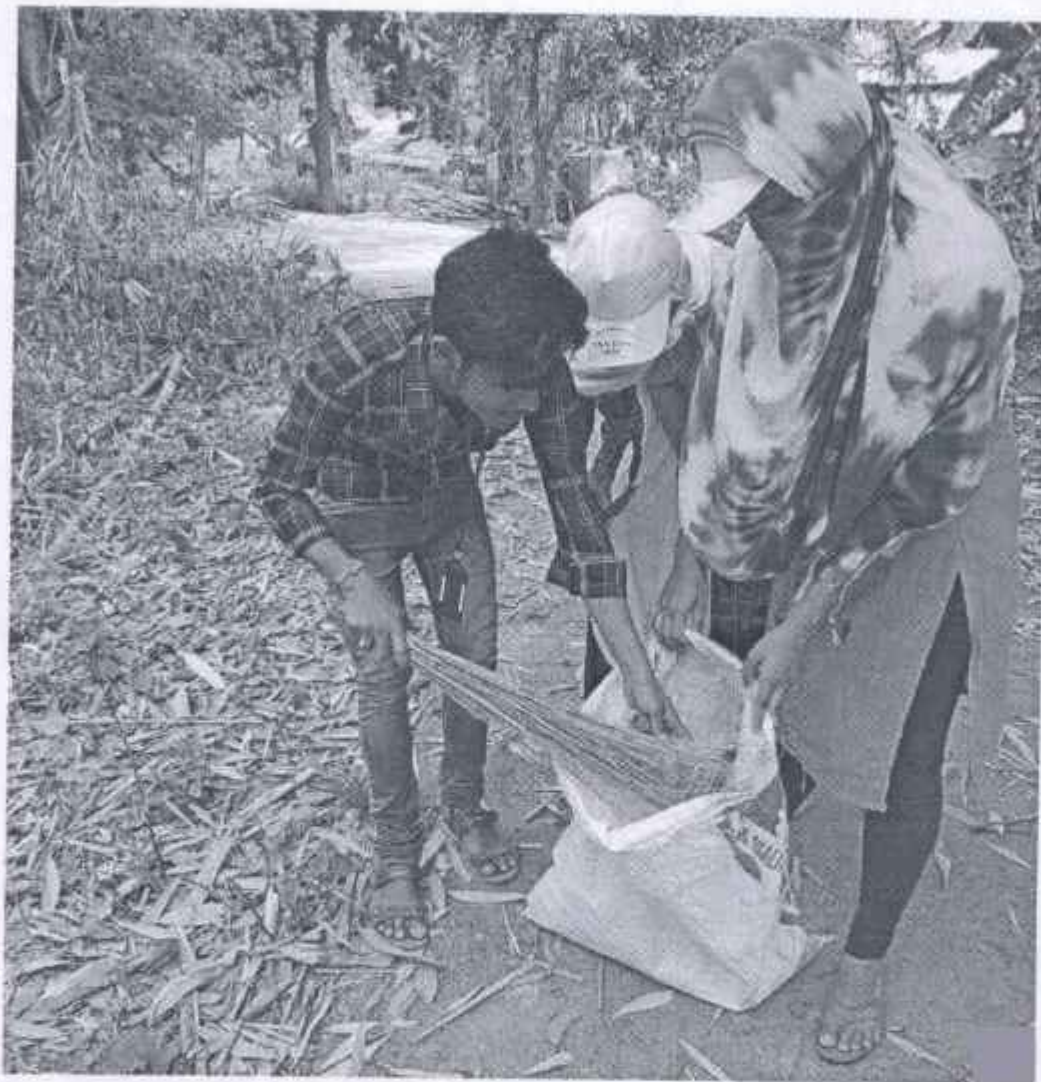



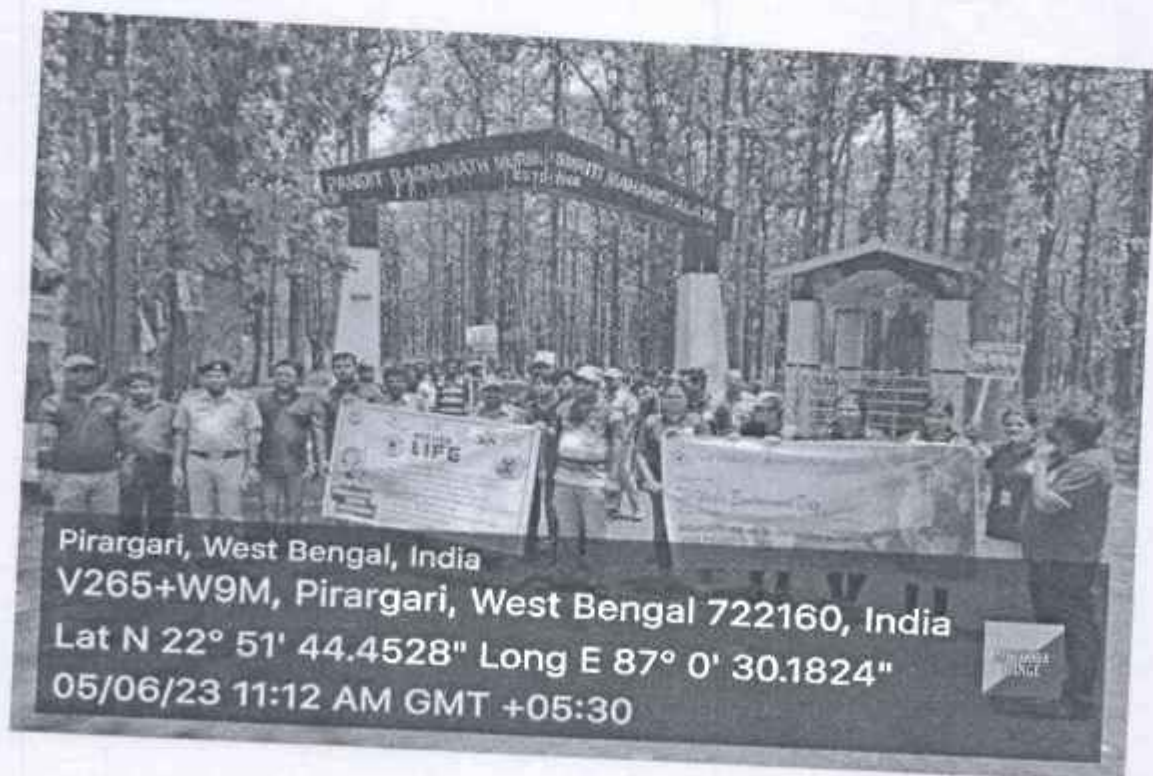


REPORT



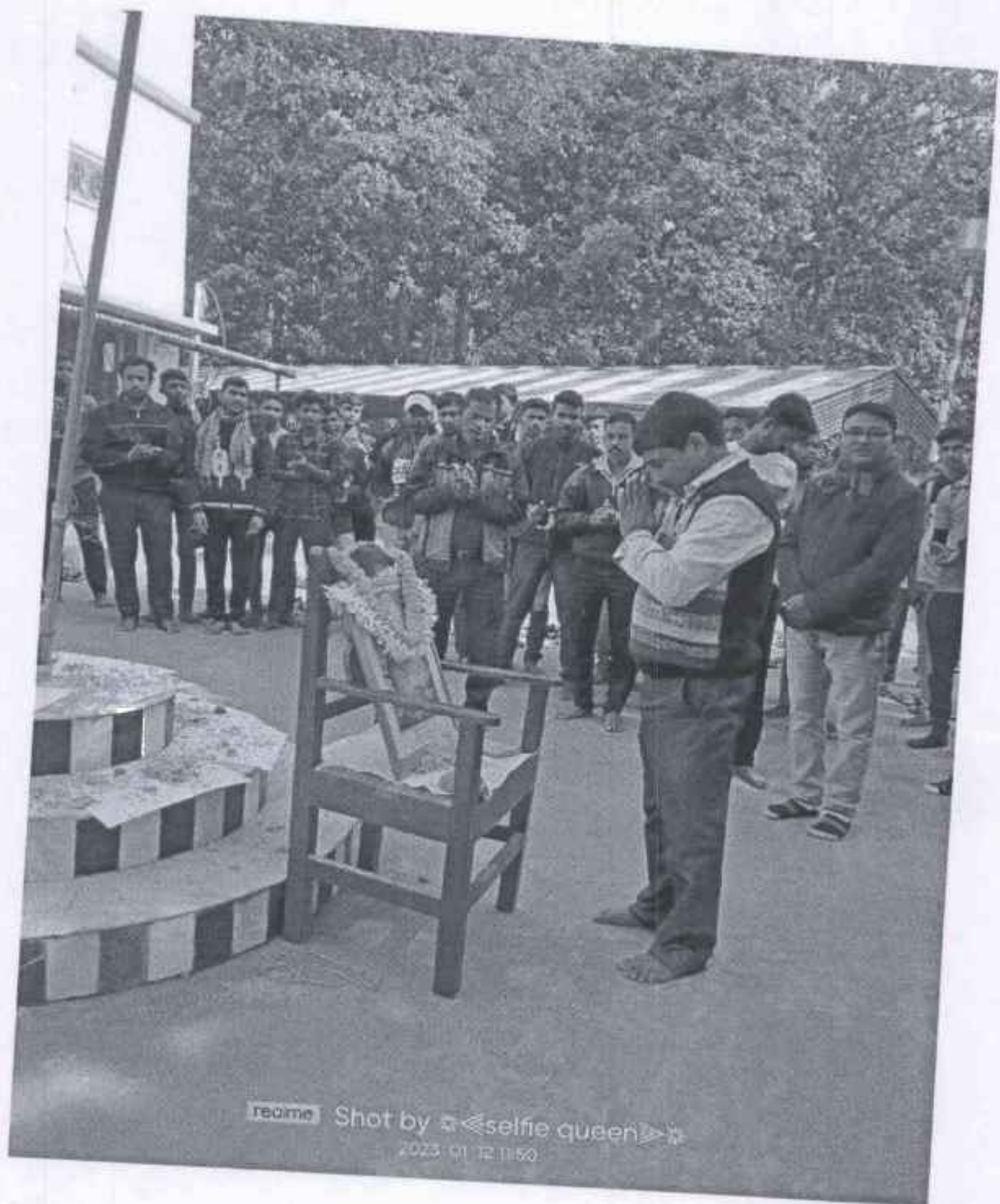
OBJECTIVES:
