OBJECTIVES:

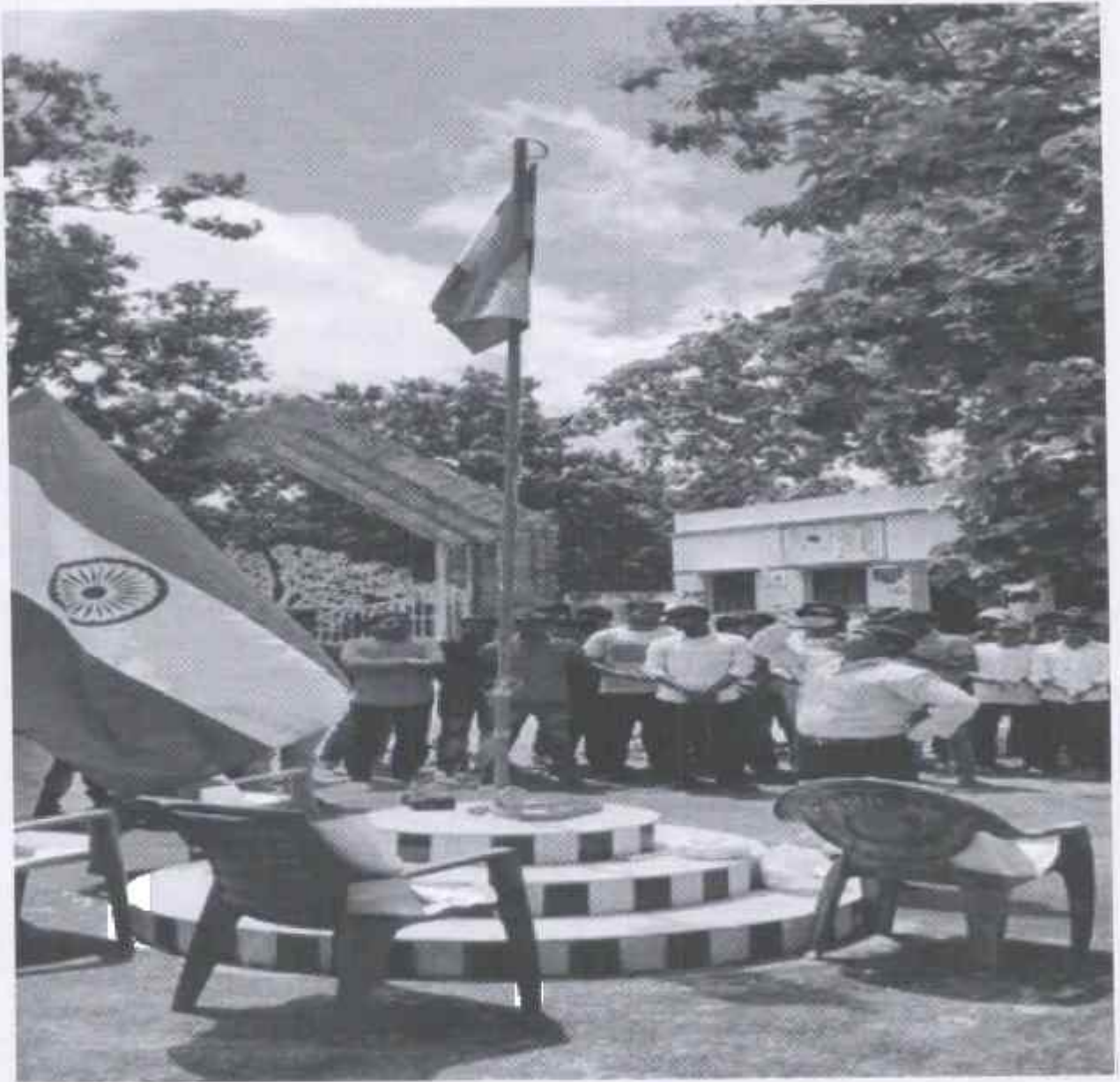



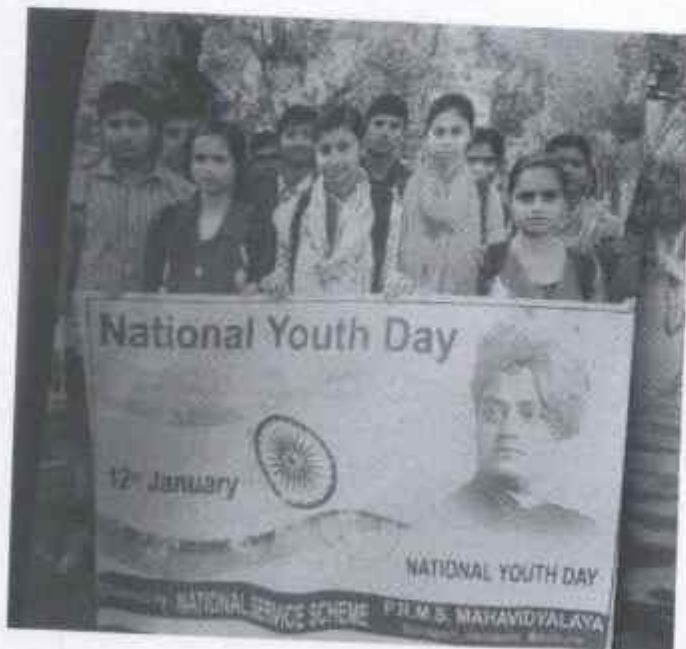
Mental Health Awareness:
