REPORT

Dengue is a mosquito-borne viral infection prevalent in tropical and subtropical regions worldwide. It is caused by the dengue virus, which is transmitted mainly by *Aedes aegypti* mosquitoes. Symptoms range from mild fever to severe flu-like symptoms and, in severe cases, can lead to dengue haemorrhagic fever or dengue shock syndrome, both of which can be fatal.

Necessity of Dengue Awareness program:

1. **Prevention and control:** Awareness programs educate the public on preventive measures such as eliminating mosquito breeding sites, using mosquito repellents, and wearing protective clothing. Knowledge about these practices is crucial to control the spread of the virus.
2. **Early Detection and Treatment:** Educating communities about the symptoms of dengue encourages early medical consultation, which can prevent complications and reduce mortality rates. Awareness programs also inform about the importance of hydration and medical care.
3. **Reducing Economic Burden:** Dengue outbreaks can lead to significant healthcare costs and economic losses due to decreased productivity. Awareness programs can help reduce these financial burdens by preventing large-scale outbreaks.
4. **Community Involvement:** Effective dengue control requires community participation. Awareness programs can mobilize communities to take collective action, such as community clean-up drives to eliminate stagnant water where mosquitoes breed.
5. **Public Health Improvement:** These programs contribute to overall public health improvements by promoting general hygiene and environmental health practices that benefit the community beyond dengue prevention.



Key Components of Dengue Awareness Program:

- 1.Educational Campaigns:** Dissemination of information through posters, pamphlets, social media, and public service announcements about dengue transmission, symptoms, and preventive measures.
- 2.School/College Programs:** Integrating dengue education into school curricula to teach children about the importance of mosquito control and personal protection.
- 3.Community Workshops:** Organizing workshops and seminars in communities to demonstrate practical measures for mosquito control and to provide health education.
- 4.Health Worker Training:** Training healthcare professionals to recognize dengue symptoms early and to manage cases effectively, including the proper protocol for severe cases.
- 5.Collaboration With Media:** Partnering with local media to spread awareness messages widely and consistently, especially during peak transmission seasons.
- 6.Use of technology:** Leveraging mobile apps and SMS services to send reminders and information about dengue prevention and outbreaks to the public.

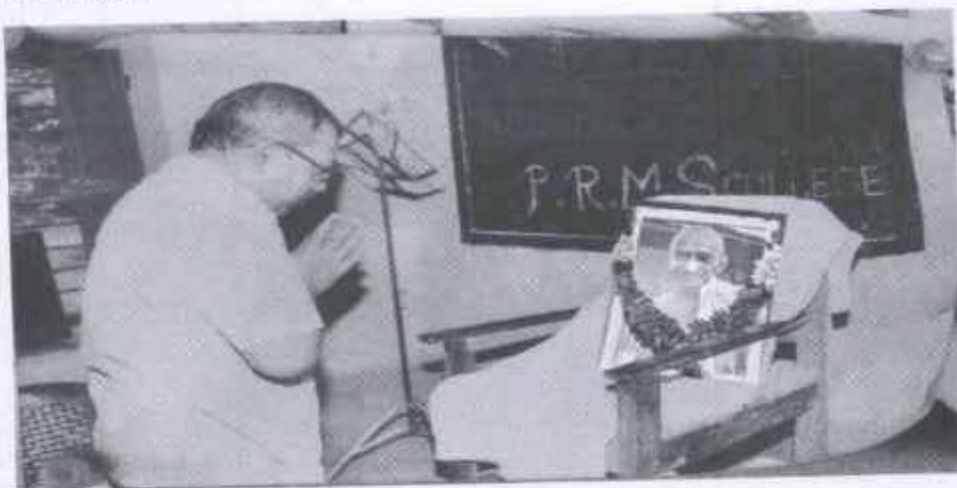

OBJECTIVES:

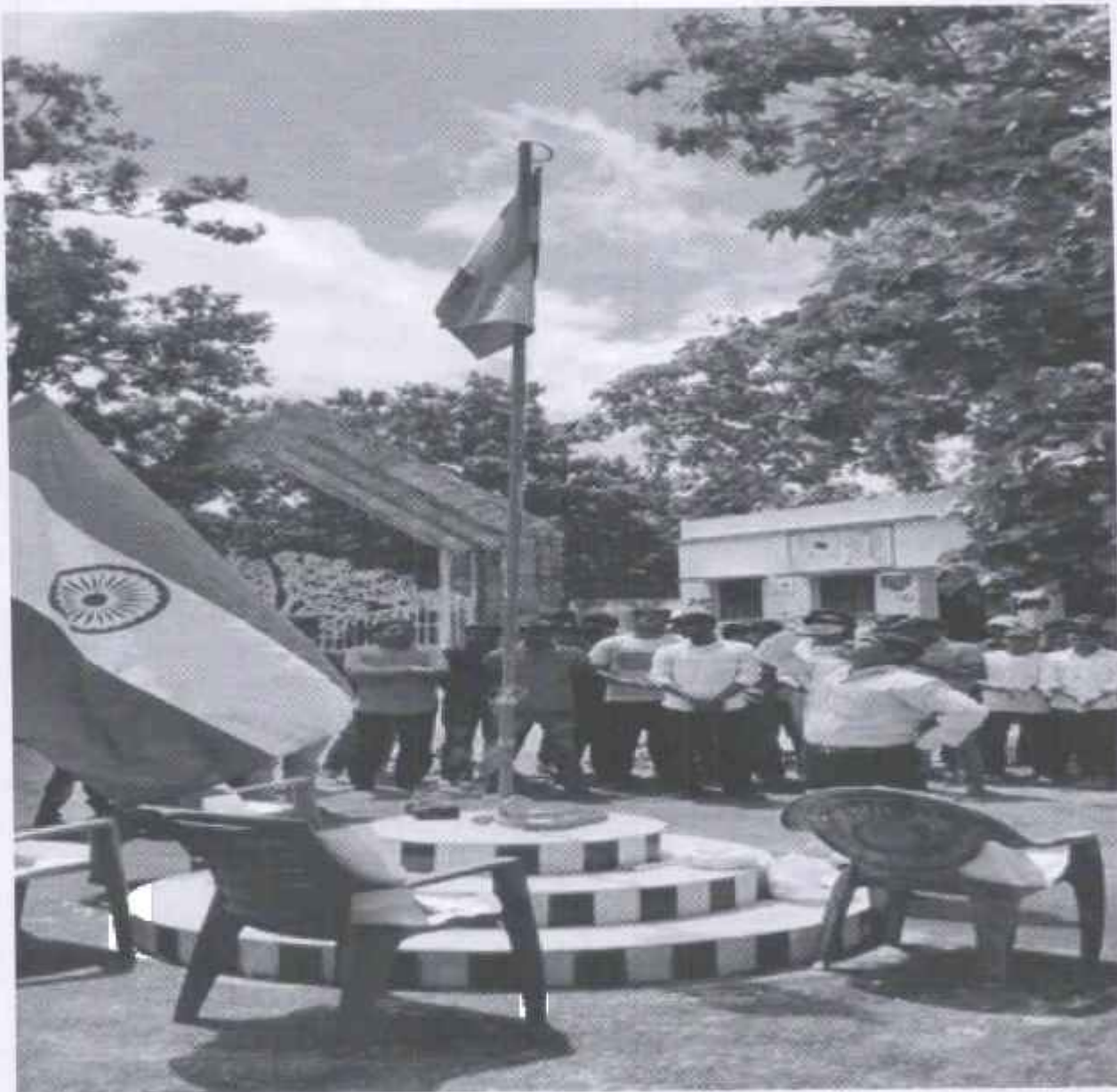

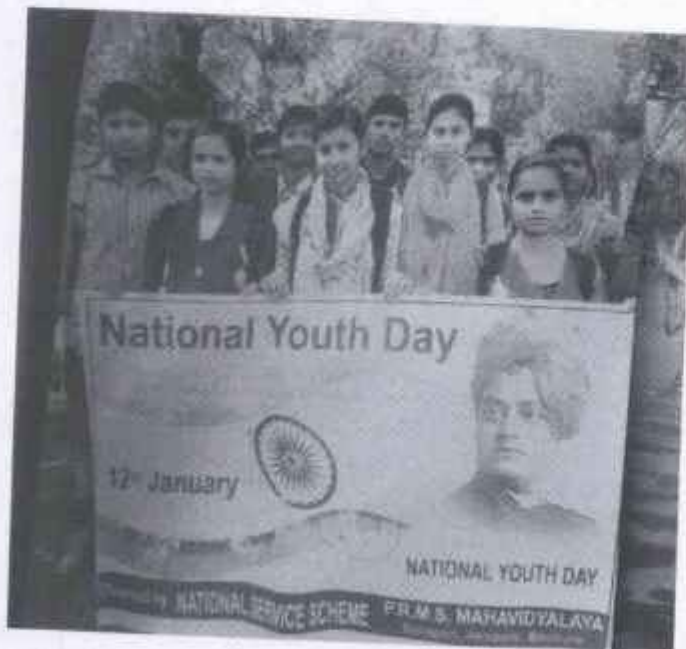
Mental Health Awareness:
