
TEACHERS' DAY CELEBRATION

Event Highlights


Opening Ceremony:

The joyful and respectful environment created during the celebration contributed to a positive and harmonious atmosphere within the college.




SARASWATI PUJA CELEBRATION AT PRMS MAHAVIDYALAYA


Necessity of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan:






