



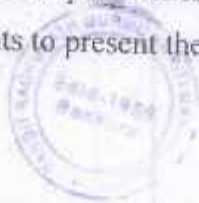

6. **Community empowerment:** Involving local communities in sanitation efforts empowers them to take charge of their environment. Community-led initiatives and participation ensure the sustainability of cleanliness efforts.

1. **Construction of Toilets:** Building household and public toilets to eliminate open defecation, particularly in rural areas and urban slums.

6. Corporate and NGO Participation: Encouraging partnerships with businesses and non-governmental organizations to support sanitation projects and contribute resources.
