
Figure 2 BEAT REDOLENT OF TRIBAL VIBE




Figure 1 OUR PRINCIPAL OFFERING GARLAND




Figure 2 STUDENT OFFERING PRAYER




Figure 5 RHYTHMIC BEAT





Hul Divas is observed annually on June 30 in memory of tribals — Sidho and Kanhu
 Murmu — who led the Santhal hul (rebellion) on June 30, 1855, at Bhognadih in Sahebganj
 district.

On 30 June 1855, a large number of Santals assembled in a field in Bhognadih, they declared themselves as free and took oath under the leadership of Sidho Murmu and Kanhu Murmu to fight unto the last against the British rulers as well as their agents.

It started on June 30, 1855 and lasted until January 3, 1856 when the movement was brutally ended by troops loyal to the British.

In the memory of Santhal Hul (rebellion), Hul Divas (Rebellion Day) is celebrated each year on the same date 30 June, especially among Santhal tribes.





REPORT

Raghunath Murmu (5 May 1905 – 1 February 1982) was an Indian Santali writer and educator. He developed the OI Chiki script for Santali language. Until the nineteenth century, Santali people had no written language and knowledge was transmitted orally from one generation to other. Later European researchers and Christian missionaries started to use Bengali, Odia, and Roman scripts to document the Santali language. However, Santalis did not have their own script. His development of the OI Chiki script enriched the cultural identity of the Santali society. He wrote many songs, plays and school text books in the OI Chiki script.

Raghunath Murmu was born on the day of Baisakhi Purnima (Buddha Purnima), 1905 in the Dandbose (Dahardih) village (near Rairangpur town) of Mayurbhanj State (now in Odisha), India.

He has not only given a new identity to the Santali society but also has laid an inspiration for other societies to create their own script. Because of this inspiration, many societies are now able to develop their own script. The Government of India has included the Santali language in the Eighth Schedule of the constitution of India on 22 December 2003. After that, many state governments of India, specifically West Bengal, Jharkhand, Odisha, and Bihar, gave recognition to the Santali language. The government of Jharkhand, Odisha, and West Bengal included the Santali language as a medium of instruction at the primary and high school levels in the santal-dominated area. Many universities and colleges of Jharkhand, West Bengal and Odisha are now offering courses on the Santali literature using OI Chiki script

The Birth anniversary of Pandit Raghunath Murmu was observed on 5th may by the Department of Santali comsplendour. The function was in inaugurate by garlanding the Statue of Pandit Raghunath Murmu.mr. Ram Mandi head of the Department took the responsibility. The dignitaries who were present in the function were the Head of the Department and all the teachers of the Department. Governing Body President mr. Mrityunjoy Murmu Dr. Nilangshu Ghosh Principal of P.R.M.S Mahavidyalaya and government nominee Mr. Tarashankar Mahapatra and with Mr. Tarapada Mahapatra (Donor Member) decorated the chief Guest Chair.

The function started by feliciting the guest and inaugural song .The guest and teacher's delivered their speeches on Pandit Raghunath Murmu, many unknown facts cane to lite, the students were enriched.

At last the student's made it a grant success with their dance, song and recitation.Mr.Ram Mandi head of the department of Santali announcing the end of the event.







Majhi or Manjhi title is the honoured title of the Village headman or village leading person among santal tribes since immemorable time. Since, Manjhi playa a crucial roal for worship and leading the santal community and revered as Majhi Baba. He took up arms against the British in the 1784, around 70 years before Mangaj Pandey. He organized the adivasi predominantly santal to form an armed group to fight against the resource grabbing and exploitation of British.
