



Figure 1 OUR PRINCIPAL OFFERING GARLAND




Figure 2 STUDENT OFFERING PRAYER

OUTCOMES:








REPORT




Key Components of Dengue Awareness Program:




Figure 1 RESULT OF DEDICATION





Figure 2 OUR MASTER TRAINER




Figure 3 RESULT OF OUR DEDICATED EFFORT

Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (Clean India Mission) is a nationwide campaign initiated by the Government of India in 2014, aiming to clean up the streets, roads, and infrastructure of India's cities, towns, and rural areas. The mission emphasizes improving sanitation, eliminating open defectation, and promoting sustainable waste management practices. It was launched to commemorate the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, who advocated for cleanliness and sanitation.

Necessity of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan:

- 1.Reduction of Open Defecation: Open defecation poses significant health risks, including the spread of infectious diseases and contamination of water sources. The mission aims to eliminate open defecation by constructing toilets and promoting their use, which is crucial for public health and dignity.
- 2.Environmental Protection: Unmanaged waste leads to pollution of land and water bodies. By promoting waste segregation, recycling, and proper disposal methods, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan helps protect the environment and promotes sustainable practice
- 3.Economic Benefits: Improved sanitation leads to a healthier population, which in turn can reduce healthcare costs and increase productivity. Cleanliness also boosts tourism, as cleaner cities and tourist spots are more attractive to visitors.
- 4.Behavioural Changes: The mission emphasizes changing attitudes towards cleanliness and sanitation through education and awareness campaigns. Encouraging personal responsibility for cleanliness can lead to long-term societal benefits.
- 5.Public Health Improvement: Poor sanitation is a leading cause of diseases like diarrhoea, cholera, and dysentery, particularly affecting children. Improved sanitation facilities reduce the prevalence of these diseases, contributing to better overall public health.
- 6.Community empowerment: Involving local communities in sanitation efforts empowers them to take charge of their environment. Community-led initiatives and participation ensure the sustainability of cleanliness efforts.

Aims and Objectives of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan:

1. Construction of Toilets: Building household and public toilets to eliminate open defecation, particularly in rural areas and urban slums.

- 5.Involvement of Technology: Utilizing technology for monitoring and managing waste, as well as for spreading awareness through digital platforms.
