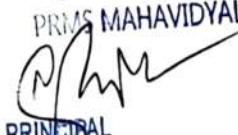

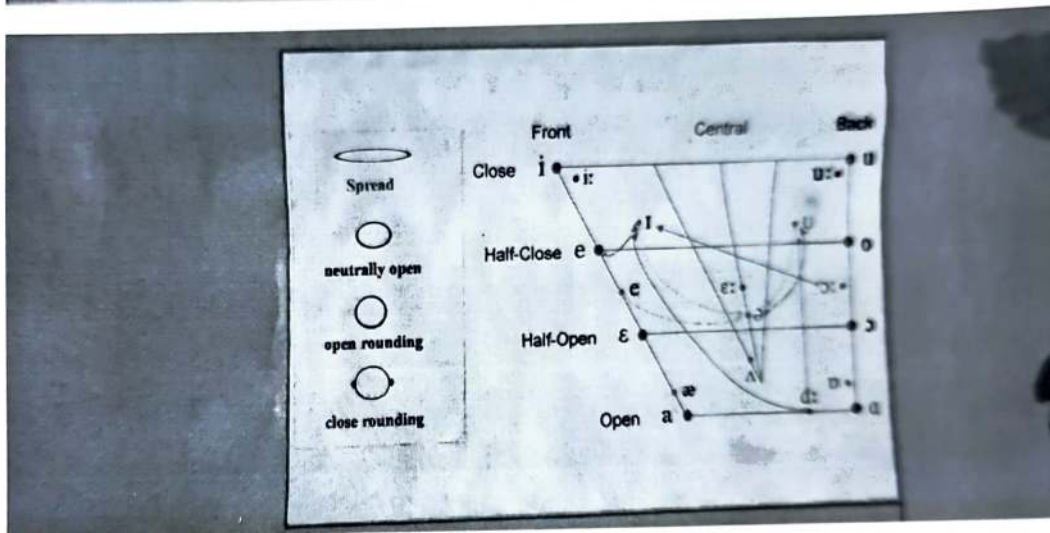
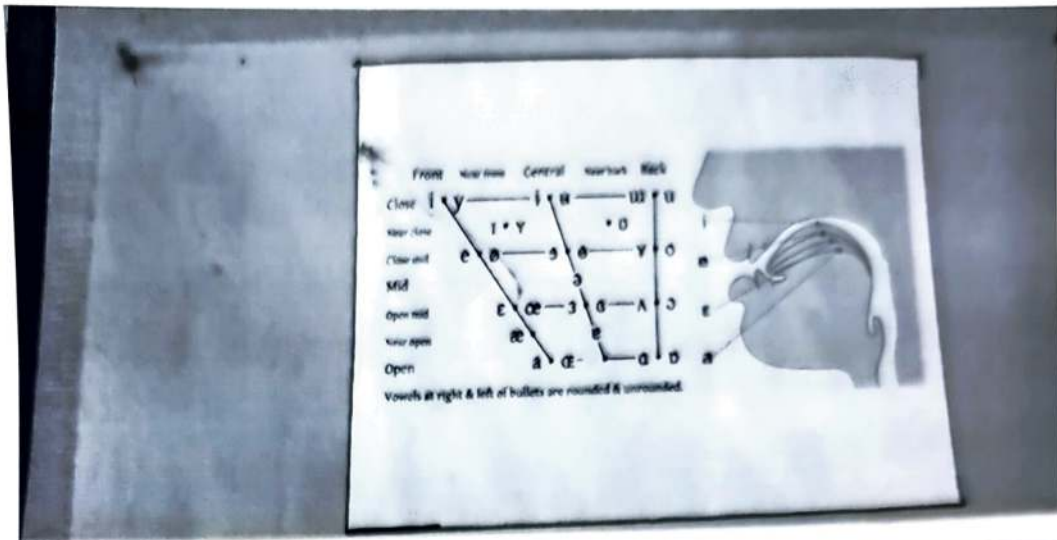

1.2 Speech organs (vocal organs)

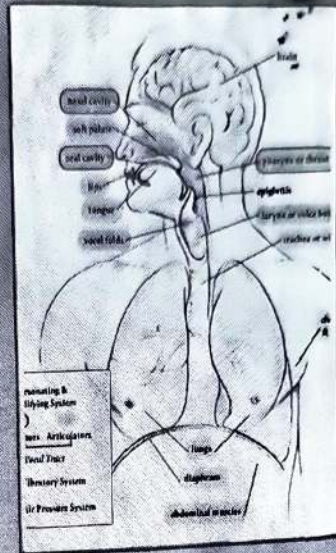
- The parts of the human body involved in the production of speech.

- The air- stream coming from the lungs is modified in various ways in these cavities, resulting in the production of various sounds.



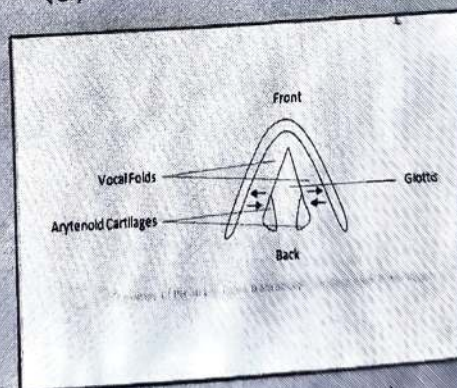
Areas of phonetics

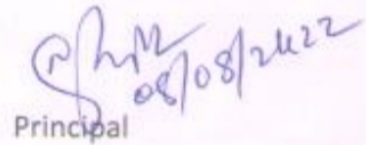

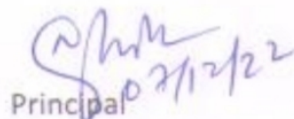
